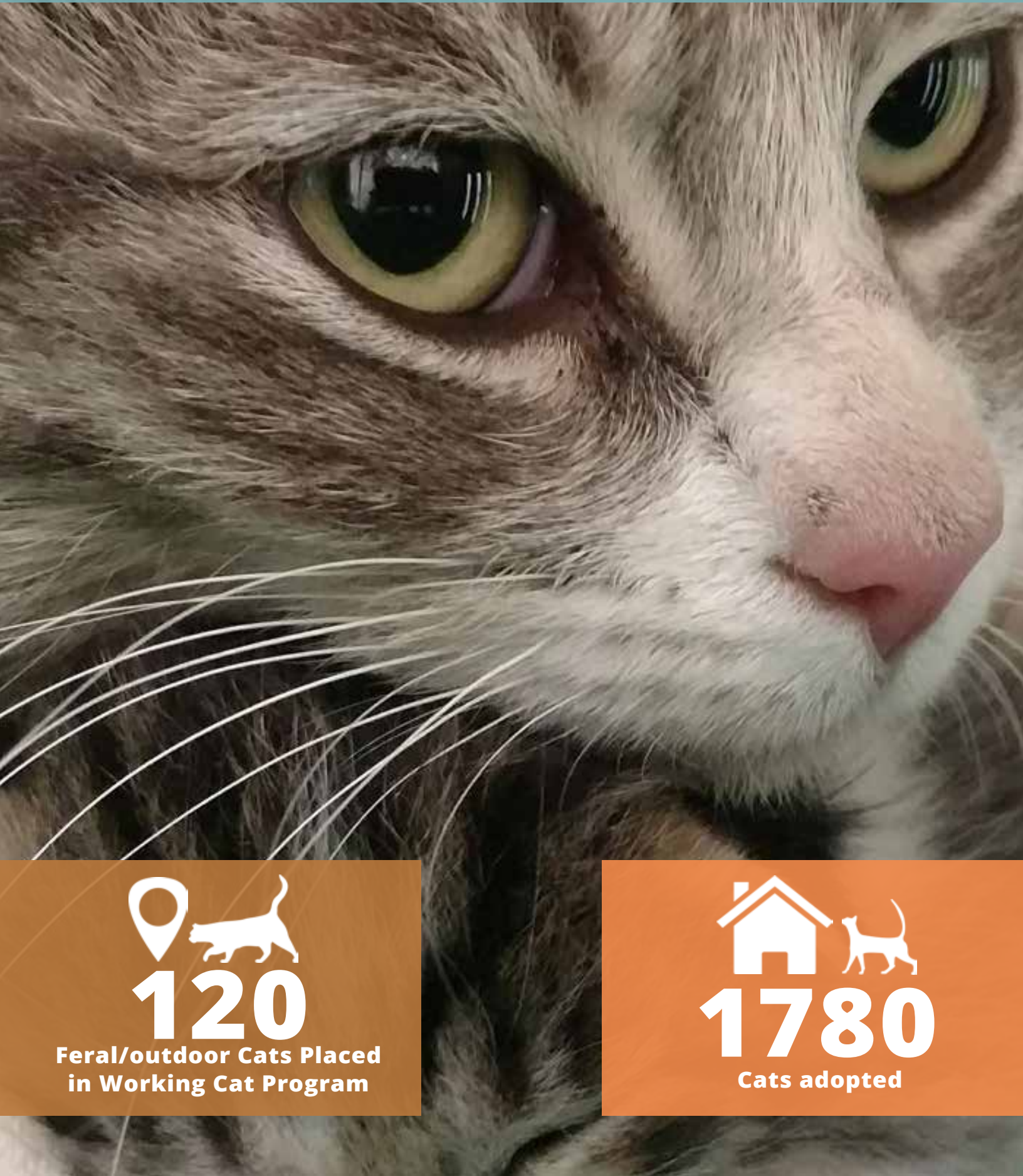

An average cat has 1-8 kittens per litter and 2-3 litters per year. During the female productive cycle, one female cat could have 100 kittens. A single pair of cats and their offspring can produce 420,000 cats in 7 years!
