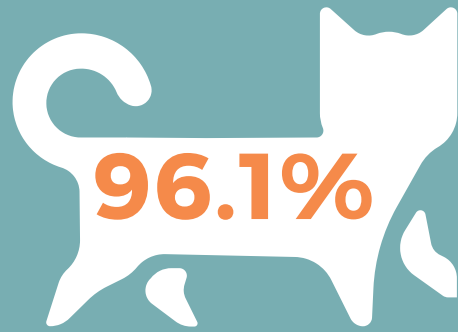
TOWN CATS' MISSION

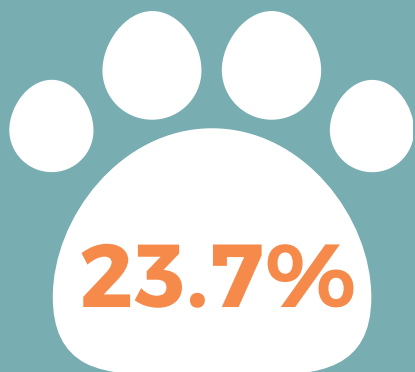

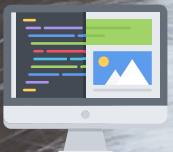
